Notes for HANS BELLINGER:

Jones (1985) wrote, "The earliest known ancestor of the American line was Hans Bellinger, called a citizen of Steinau an der Strabe at a son's marriage in 1664 (Rodembach)" (p. 48). They are buried in Rodembach, Germany.

She was born Abt. 1644 in Germany [of Klattingen near Lotharingen near Metz]<sup>3</sup>, and died Abt. April 01, 1695 in Rodembach, Germany at age 60.

Notes for DIETERICH BELLINGER:

He was buried on June 25, 1722 in Germany (source: Jones, Henry Z., The Palatine Families of New York: A Study of the German Immigrants Who Arrived in Colonial New York in 1710, Universal City, CA, 1985, p. 48.).

3. NICHOLAUS<sup>2</sup> BELLINGER (*HANS*<sup>1</sup>) was born Abt. 1646 in Steinau an der Strasse, Rodenbach, Germany, and died in NY?. He married ANNA KUHN November 25, 1685 in Langenselbold, Germany, daughter of HANS KUHN and CATHARINA. She was born Abt. 1660, and died Bef. 1716.

Notes for NICHOLAUS BELLINGER:

Nicholaus first appeared on the Hunter Subsistence Lists (#36) 4 Aug 1710 with 6 persons over age 10 in the family, after immigrating to New York with the German Palatines in 1710. He appears on the Simmendinger census as a widower with one child. In 1717, his married sons Marcus and Heinrich were living in adjacent houses in New Annsbury, NY (Barker, 1986, p. 22).

Notes for ANNA KUHN:

She was declared incompatible with her first husband, so they "went away" from each other. "By order of the noble government" she was allowed to marry Nicholas Bellinger, after they had an illegitimate child. The child was legitimized and the Pastor at Langenselbold was ordered to marry them (Jones, 1985, p. 50).

Notes for MARCUS BELLINGER:

Marcus is #38 on the Hunter Lists on 4 Oct 1710, and was probably the illegitimate child of his parents, conceived before they married. On 24 Dec 1711, he had 4 persons over 10 years of age and 1 under 10 in his family (Jones, 1985, p. 50). He sponsored his uncle, Samuel Kuhn, in 1714. Marcus Bellenger of Annsburg was a Palatine soldier to Canada in 1711.

Notes for HEINRICH PHILIPS BELLINGER: Baptised: January 16, 1686/87, Huttengesab, Germany His entries on the Hunter lists began in 1711. On 24 June 1711, he was noted with 2 persons over 10 and 1 person under 10 years. He was a Palatine soldier to Canada, and he later settled in the Schoharie region.

4. JOHANNES<sup>3</sup> BELLINGER (*DIETERICH*<sup>2</sup>, *HANS*<sup>1</sup>) was born Bef. November 17, 1664 in Germany near Rodenbach<sup>7</sup>, and died Aft. 1725 in Herkimer Co, NY. He married ANNA MARIA MARGARETHA KUHN April 24, 1690 in Langenselbold, Germany<sup>8</sup>, daughter of HANS KUHN and CATHARINA. She was born Bef. August 11, 1661 in Germany, and died Aft. April 30, 1725 in NY.

Notes for JOHANNES BELLINGER:

Johannes was baptized on November 17, 1664 in Rodenbach, Nassau Hessen, Germany. In 1710 about 1200 German Palatines were brought to Columbia Co, NY as indentured servants, and about the same number were settled on the west bank of the Hudson River. They were set free in 1712, but were not given the land that was promised them. Some moved on but many of the families stayed in Columbia and surrounding counties. This is probably the Johannes Bellinger listed in 1714 "The Book of Names, Especially Relating to the Early Palatines and the First Settlers in the Mohawk Valley." Other Bellingers listed were: Nicolaus, Marcus, Henrich, and Elizabetha. Marcus and Henrich are shown as being in the East Camp, Soldiers in the Canadian Expedition of 1711. David A. Bellinger wrote that "The German (Palatine) Bellingers were driven from Steinau An Der Strasse and other southern German villages in 1709.

Queen Anne's London Board of Trade offered passage for approximately 3000 destitute Palatines on 10 ships destined for the New World (America) with requirement that the favored Palatines work as laborers to provide tar urgently needed by the British Navy. Several hundred died enroute to America. More than 1800 Palatines were settled in Oct. 1710 at Livingston manor, 90 miles north of New York City on the Hudson River. "Johannes Bellinger (Hunter Lists #37) and other family members were the first caucasians in upstate New York Wilderness and finally settled in 1723 in what is now Herkimer Co, NY." Jones (1985) asserts that "... all the emigrant Bellingers of 1709 were related, but not in the way previously thought" (p. 47). "Johannes was called a carpenter in 1699 (Langenselbold) and was listed as having one horse at Huttengesab 3 March 1701 (Birstein Archives)" (Jones, 1985, p. 49). He first appeared on the Hunter lists 4 Aug 1710 with 4 persons over 10 years of age. In a Palatine debt book dated 1712, Johannes was listed among several carpenters. In 1716, Johannes was living in NeuQuunsberg. On April 30, 1725, he was a patentee on the north side of the Mohawk River.

HARTMAN WINDECKER Abt. 1710, son of JOHAN WINDECKER and ANNA HERDT. He was born October 1683 in Nidda, Germany<sup>9</sup>, and died in PA<sup>?</sup>.

Notes for CAPT. HARTMAN WINDECKER:

Hartman Windecker was named as a List master on the East side of the Hudson River in Annsbury in 1711. Nearby in Queensbury, the List master was John Conrad Weiser. Hartman was on a list of immigrants to [now berks Co] Pennsylvania, and he is thought to have traveled to PA in about 1727 with a party led by Conrad Weiser, whose home in Berks Co. is now a popular attraction.

John was in Klock's Company in 1763. His will was written on June 25, 1791 and probated on November 10, 1794 (source: Jones, Henry Z., *The Palatine Families of New York: A Study of the German Immigrants Who Arrived in Colonial New York in 1710*, Universal City, CA, 1985, p. 1101).

Notes for CATHERINE DIEVENDORF:

This may be the Catherine who married Johannes Windecker, who was in Klock's company in 1763. His will was dated 25 June 1791 and probated 10 Nov 1794 (Montgomery Co. Will Book I). They were married in Stone Arabia Reformed Church 29 Oct 1765. Her will was dated 5 May 1810 and probated 3 Jan 1811 (Herkimer Co. Will Book B).

Notes for JOHANN FRIEDERICH "FREDERICK" BELLINGER:

"Fred Bellinger of Queensbury was a soldier in 1711 (Palatine Volunteers To Canada) and was naturalized 22 Nov 1715 (Albany Naturalizations)" (Jones, 1985, p. 49). He and his father did carpentry work at Livingston Manor, NY. In the record of his will, he is called "yeoman." His executors were son-in-law Jacob Klock and Hendrick Frey. His son Thomas is mentioned in the Calendar of Wills (Ancestry.com).

Notes for LIEUT. JACOB DIEVENDORF:

Lieutenant or Captain in the Revolutionary War. Jacob was a farmer who owned considerable property in the town of Root, where he and his father were early settlers. He is called the first white settler of Root, actually settling in Currytown prior to the Revolutionary War. Jacob's will was dated 28 Feb 1816 and probated 1 Feb 1917 (sources: Bell, 1932; Montgomery Co, NY, Calendar of Wills). His residence was listed as Charleston. The will is excellent documentation of his living family. I found it interesting that Jacob willed "my seat No. five on the Gallery in the white church in Curry Town" to Jacob Stowits, son of his daughter Margaret and George Stowits. He left his pew No. 4 on the lower floor to his 3 grandsons and he left seat No. 5 on the lower floor to his six granddaughters. Jacob's wife was not mentioned in the will, providing evidence of her earlier death. The cemetery where Jacob and Elizabeth are buried is Dievendorf Burial Lot, Root, Montgomery Co, NY, "located in a pasture about 400 feet southeast of the Hubschmitt home, which is on the Sloansville Road. The cemetery is surrounded by a metal fence, still in good condition, and contains three monuments, visible from the road. The cemetery is grown up with trees and brush, mostly poison ivy, making the location of the stones difficult. Many of the stones are lying on the ground, partially buried. The owner of the land mentioned some unmarked fieldstones which I failed to locate. I cannot be positive that I located every tombstone" (Elswick, Albert, Copied 1 Aug 1967).

Jacob was taken south to Sharon, and the Indians began killing prisoners. He was scalped by Indians and left for dead. He was found the next day by Col. Vedder and taken to Stone Arabia, where he remained for five years. Later in life, he became very wealthy in land, but he always suffered pain and discomfort from his scalp wound. AN ADDRESS BY WILLIAM IRVING WALTER OF ST. JOHNSVILLE, N.Y.

Delivered Before the Herkimer County Historical Society, April 11, 1903.

Christian Bellinger was born in 1764 and came to Danube in 1792. He was a son of Frederick Bellinger and with his younger brother, Andrew, was captured by the Indians and taken to Canada at the destruction of Currytown in 1781. On his return he married Barbara, daughter of Jacob Diefendorf, a leading resident of that locality. He died in 1838. His son, Philip C. Bellinger, lived on the farm until his death in February, 1872, and it is now in the possession of his only surviving son, Washington. Philip C. Bellinger was a prominent figure in town for many years and he left an enviable reputation as a man of strict business integrity. His wife was a member of the Zimmerman family and their descendants in Danube and Minden are quite numerous. Jacob, a brother of Philip, died in the town of Little Falls in 1859 where his descendants still reside. Of the daughters of Christian Bellinger, one married Conrad Snell of Danube, one Abraham Snell of Minden, and one Conrad Mowers of Stark. Montgomery Co, NY. Could they be related to John H. Cook (Columbia Co)? Did he have brothers in Madison Co, NY? Ellie related that a descendant of Adam Henry told that his family name was Koche and they had immigrated from Holland to New York.

The 1850 census shows that Adam H. and his wife were in Lenox Twp, Madison Co, NY in 1850. Could it be they went there when his father died, having inherited his land? Lennox was formed in 1809 from Sullivan, NY, and Madison Co. became a separate county in 1806. Chenango Co. was formed in 1798 from Herkimer and Tioga counties, and Madison was included. They must have sold their land sometime between 1850 and 1860, because they bought land in Pilot Twp, Vermilion Co, IL by 1860 and were listed on the 28 July 1860 census in Middlefork Twp. From 1864 - 1872, Adam bought and sold several pieces of property and appears to have made some money through the sales. Adam bought land on September 16, 1864 from Richard Courtney for \$1200. He sold land on March 03, 1869 to Jacob C. Smith for \$2125. He bought land on October 08, 1870 from Francis Harper for \$2400. On February 17, 1872 he sold land to John M. Phipps for \$2800. Then on April 21, 1872, he purchased land in Sec 6, Twp 20N, Range 12 W (in Blount Twp just north of Lake Vermilion) for \$300 from Daniel Kincade (source: Land records researched by Ellie Stephens). According to Ellie Cook Stephens, the 1875 Atlas shows A.H. Cook owned 60 acres of land in Blount Twp. B.A. Cook owned 80 acres next door. From muster To Feb 28th 1862, he is reported present; To June 30/62 absent on det service in Hosp at Capville, since March 11, 1862; July and Aug 1861 to Dec 31/62 - present; Jan and Feb 1863. Missing in action Dec 31/62. "Captured at the battle of Murfusboro, Tenn., Dec 31/64; paroled at City Point, Va., Jany 26/63; reported at Camp Parole, Md., date not stated and was sent to Benton Bks, Mo., March 11, 1863, where he appears on muster roll as present in March and sick in Hospital April 1863 - date he rejoined company not stated" (source: Illinois GenWeb Civil War Veterans).

Roll of Company for May and June/63 reports him s---- Gen. Hosp. St. Louis, Mo., from Benton Bks June 6/63. His name is on a stone slab at the park at Pea Ridge, Ark., he was at this battle field during

the war. The battle of Pea Ridge was fought March 7-8, 1862; it decided the fate of Missouri for the Union. Subsequently, to April 30/64, reported present. Wounded in the face in action at Nose Creek (Kenesaw Mountain) Ga., June 20-28, 1864-exact date cannot be stated" Mustered out with Company Sept 27, 1864. The rest was in action at Murfreesboro, Tenn., Dec 31, 1862, and engaged in actions near Kenesaw Mountain, Ga, during June, 1864. He was honorably discharged on the 1st of June 1864 in Springfield, Illinois. Nelson's papers state that while supporting a battery of men, he received a gun shot wound of the left cheek which greatly injures his left eye and painfully affects his head. The pain Nelson suffered may have very well been the cause of the marriage break up between him and his wife Amanda in 1889. She left the state, and died in 1898 possibly in Oklahoma. Nelson later married Pheobe J. Hardesty Davis, widow of Joseph Davis also of the 35th. Both were from Vermilion Co, IL. Application for Pension No. 256.571
