1. JACOB H.<sup>1</sup> HOCHSTETLER, SR. was born Abt. 1680 in Ste. Marie-aux-Mines, Alsace, France, and died in Alsace, France.

Notes for JACOB H. HOCHSTETLER, SR.: In 1709, Jacob Sr. lived in Echery, and he bought a farm on 16 May 1711 at Petite Lievre for 900 L.T. Jacob Sr. was a neighbor and colleague of Jacob Amman, leader of the Amish wing of the Anabaptists in Alsace (source: Hochstetler Family Newsletter, XVI, No. 3, Sept 2002). In July 1714 he was living in the neighborhood of La Petite Liepvre in Ste. Marie-aux-Mines, Alsace. The Waglers lived nearby in Muesbach. Jacob Amman also lived there in 1712, the date when the Anabaptists were ordered to leave.

3. JACOB<sup>2</sup> HOCHSTETLER (*JACOB H.<sup>1</sup>*) was born Abt. 1712 in Echery near St. Marie-aux-Mines in Alsace (now France), and died January 01, 1782 in Lebanon Co, PA near Annville Twp. He married (1) UNKNOWN Abt. 1729 in Switzerland. She was born Abt. 1712 in Germany, and died September 20, 1757 in Bern Twp, Berks Co, PA during Indian Raid. He married (2) ANNA ? Aft. 1757 in PA.

Notes for JACOB HOCHSTETLER: Jacob left Rotterdam and arrived in Philadelphia 9 Nov 1738 with his wife and two small children on the ship, "Charming Nancy." He was 26 years old when he arrived in America. Originally in 1737, they settled near Shartlesville in the Northkill area of what is now Berks County with others of their faith, called Amish Mennonites in the New World. Set in the Blue Mountains, the Northkill settlement was on the edge of the frontier. This settlement is known as the place where most other Pennsylvania Amish communities originated. The region was first opened for settlement in 1736. In a 1757 attack by a band of Delaware Indians, Jacob's wife and two of his children were killed. There is debate about the name of his wife, but records are all clear that she died at the Indian attack in 1757. Jacob escaped from his Indian captives about 1760 and returned to Berks Co, PA. He and John appeared on the tax list for 1762 in Bern Township. Jacob purchased a 43 acre farm about 10 miles south of the massacre site in what is

now North Heidelberg Twp on 28 June 1765. A later deed was recorded at Lancaster Co, PA on 17 Feb 1776. In 1773, Jacob sold the land on which his son, John, was living, and on 18 Nov 1773 deeded John the old farm of 150 acres where the Indian attack occurred. In all of the recorded land deeds, Jacob signed with an "X." Jacob's name appears on the Heidelberg Township lists of 1765 to 1774, but he was living in Berks Co, PA in March 1775.

4. BARBARA<sup>3</sup> HOCHSTETLER (*JACOB*<sup>2</sup>, *JACOB H.*<sup>1</sup>) was born 1732 in Europe, and died Abt. 1787 in Shartlesville or Hamburg, Berks Co, PA<sup>1</sup>. She married CHRISTIAN STUTZMAN, SR. December 1753 in Bern Twp, Berks Co, PA, son of JACOB STUTZMAN and HANNAH. He was born Abt. 1732 in Switzerland, and died Abt. September 06, 1770 in Bern or Shartlesville, Berks Co, PA, buried in Schuylkill Co, PA on private property.

Notes for BARBARA HOCHSTETLER: Barbara likely died before 1787 when her husband's farm was sold. After Christian died, she appeared on the tax lists of Bern Twp from 1771 to 1782. The son Christian appears in 1782 and continues until 1787 when he sold the land.

Notes for CHRISTIAN STUTZMAN, SR.: As a teenager, Christian was probably bound out as an indentured servant. In 1756, Christian Stutzman, of the Tulpehocken Area of Berks County, rode with the Philadelphia Company, Capt. Edward Jones, Private Independent Troop of horse during the French and Indian War. They went to John Harris' Fort (now Harrisburg), then up the Susquehanna River to Ft. Shamokin (now Sunbury) where the company joined the Augusta Regiment and became the Third Battalion which guarded the fort and the adjoining area. (from Elida's web page which sites PA Archives, 5th Series, Vol 1, p. 50; Indian Forts, Vol 1; Blue Book of Genealogical Records of Schuylkill County by Zerbe). Christian's will, which he signed with an "X", specifies that his wife Barbara can continue living on his farm, but only if she remains single. He seemed assured that she would remain unmarried after his death, and she did. The will was written on September 05, 1770 and probated on November 17, 1770 in Berks Co, PA.

JOHN<sup>3</sup> HOCHSTETLER I (*JACOB*<sup>2</sup>, *JACOB H.*<sup>1</sup>)<sup>4</sup> was born Abt. 1735 in Canton Berne, Switzerland, Europe, and died April 11, 1805 in Elklick, Somerset Co, PA, buried in Hochstetler Cemetery, Somerset Co, PA. He married (1) ANNA SCHROCK, daughter of ULY SCHROCK. She was born Abt. 1740, and died 1824. He married (2) CATHERINE HERTZLER Abt. 1750 in Hamburg, Berks Co, PA, daughter of JACOB HERTZLER and CATHERINE RUEGY. She was born Abt. 1731 in Bern, Switzerland, and died Abt. 1798 in Elk Lick Twp, Somerset Co, PA. He married (3) ANNA CHRISTNER Abt. 1796 in Somerset Co, Pennsylvania. She was born Abt. 1745 in Switzerland, and died January 01, 1824.

Notes for JOHN HOCHSTETLER I: DJH #2. According to tradition, John was about three years old when he came to the U.S. with his parents. This is probably the John Hochstetler who received a land warrant 17 Dec 1784 for 352 acres on the branch of the Elk Lick Creek in Brothers Valley Twp, Bedford County, PA. He moved from Berks to Somerset Co, PA in December, 1784 (source: Hostetler Home Page, [www.hostetler.net/origins/fdescend2.dbm](http://www.hostetler.net/origins/fdescend2.dbm)). On the 1796 Elk Lick Tax List, John and his brothers Jacob and Christian along with their sons, were assessed taxes for over 1800 acres of land. John built a simple, wood framed house on his farm in Summit Mills, Somerset Co, PA around 1800. On his will, the name was spelled John Hogstadler, but the Swiss spelling today is Hostettler. The name is also sometimes spelled Hostetler. His will was written on March 15, 1805 and filed in Elk Lick Twp, Somerset Co, PA.

Notes for JOSEPH H. HOCHSTETLER: Joseph was captured by Delaware Indians on 21 Sep 1757 at the age of 14 and was adopted by the Indians. He was returned to his family in 1764 after petitions. In about 1806, Joseph moved to Juniata Co, PA (central) to a new Amish community.

He served for many years as Justice of the Peace and was elected to the legislature for two terms against his wishes. Notes for JOSEPH HOCHSTETLER: Biographical sketch from Evans (1862): Joseph was married "to a pious sister who still survives" (p. 61). He weighed 170 pounds and stood 5 feet 8 inches tall - quite small for a man by today's standards. In the Fall 1817, he moved to Washington Co, IN and two years later he moved to Orange Co. near Orleans. From 1828 on, "Elder Hostetler is to be reckoned among the public advocates of the current Reformation" (p. 67). He traveled extensively in 1829, preaching in Kentucky, Ohio and Indiana. In 1832, he moved to Illinois, settling near Decatur where he farmed, preached, and baptised many people. In 1833, he organized the church of Christ at Decatur, and the next year he practiced medicine in that town. Joseph returned to Indiana in May 1836, settling near Bedford in Lawrence Co. Between 1838 and 1842, he taught English grammar for much of the time, while continuing as an evangelist. In 1842, he held two debates with a Mormon preacher, and also published a pamphlet. By 1844, Joseph had baptised over 3000 people. In 1849, he purchased 2000 acres of land in Wisconsin, but in 1855 he returned to Salem, Indiana. Joseph moved to Lovington, IL, where he was residing then this sketch was published.
