Generation No. 1

1. CHRISTIAN² LANTZ, SR. (*UNKNOWN*¹) was born Abt. 1732 in Lancaster Co, PA, and died February 13, 1798 in Leitersburg District, Washington Co, MD, interred Jacob's Lutheran Church, near Leitersburg, MD, close to Waynesboro¹. He married ELIZABETH February 1754 in Lancaster Co, PA, First Reformed Congregation at Lancaster, PA². She was born Abt. 1735, and died Aft. 1798 in Prob. Leitersburg District, MD.

Notes for CHRISTIAN LANTZ, SR.: Christian may be the son of immigrant, John Lantz. Jacob W. Lantz (1931) speculated that this was the young John Lents, who came to America from Germany at the age of 3 years, landing at Philadelphia 11 Aug 1732. It is also speculated that Christian Lantz, who moved to Leitersburg District, MD was a brother of John. Since there were several men of similar names who immigrated to America, I'm uncertain whether this is the right connection.

Pennsylvania, Land Warrants and Applications, 1733-1952 for Christian Lantz shows he owned 50 acres in Lancaster Co, PA on Feb. 26, 1756. Little is known of Christian's life in Lancaster County, PA. He would have been of the right age to be involved in the Indian Wars during the 1760s. I found no mention of Christian in a *History of Lancaster County* (Rupp, 1844). In 1774, residents of Lancaster County formed a committee that took subscriptions for the relief of the citizens of Boston. They collected more than 153 pounds for that purpose. In December, 1774, an election was held for representatives to the American Continental Congress, but Christian Lantz was not among the names listed. Rupp's (1844) history lists members of the Committee of Observation and the Committee of Safety but Lantz was not mentioned. I find it odd that he was not involved in patriotic committees in Lancaster Co, but a year later he was a member of several patriotic committees in Leitersburg District.

Franklin County was established on September 9, 1784 from Cumberland County, which was established in 1750. In 1775, Christian Lantz, a mason from Warwick Twp, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, purchased a 476 acre tract from John Reiff for £2,350, a considerable sum of money at that time. Could it be that he inherited money from his father? This parcel contained parts of lands patented as Tryall, Well Taught, Resurvey on Well Taught, Good and Skipton-on-Craven. "He built one of the first mills in the District" (Bell, 1898, p. 26). A large part of his landed estate is still in possession of his descendants.

During the Revolutionary War Christian Lantz served on the Committee of Safety from Upper Antietam Hundred. When the Revolutionary war began in 1776, he was a member of the County Committee of Safety from Upper Antietam Hundred (Washington Co, MD). Bet. 1775 - 1777 he served on the Committee of Observation, Upper Antietam Hundred, for Elizabethtown District. "In the Committee of Observation for Washington County, Leitersburg District was represented by Christian Lantz and Christopher Burkhart. There can be no doubt that the District contributed a fair quota of men to the Continental army, but unfortunately no record of their names or services is now accessible" (Bell, 1898, pp. 63-64). He served in the Maryland militia during the revolutionary war.

"The disappearance of old landmarks and the frequency of disputes over boundary lines resulted in 1786 in the passage of an act of Assembly authorizing the owners of contiguous lands to unite in the employment of a competent surveyor to run the lines of their respective holdings and erect permanent corner-stones. Under the provisions of this law an extensive resurvey was made in 1792, embracing the site of Leitersburg and many farms in the center of the District. The parties to this agreement" included Christian Lantz and George Lantz (Bell, 1898, p. 44).

"Christian Lantz seems to have formed the idea of erecting a mill soon after he became a resident of Leitersburg District, for in 1776 he purchased from Jacob Leiter two and one-half acres of land, the boundaries of which are

described as "Beginning at the end of thirty-two perches in the sixth line of a tract of land called Skipton-on-Craven and running from thence down Antietam creek on the northwest side of said creek * * * to include the whole of the creek and all the advantages of the water for water works." The last clause is significant. In 1783 Lantz entered into an agreement with Leiter "not to raise the water or dam further or higher than the aforesaid corners or marked stones when there is not a flow in the creek, but at all other times he and his heirs and assigns are at liberty to raise the dam or water if they choose as far as the said stones but no farther, only when the flow is high." In a provisional disposition of his lands in 1792 Christian Lantz assigned the mill property to his son Christian and adjacent land to his son George, reserving to the latter "the use of the water every Monday night, Thursday night, and Saturday night forever, to be let through a hole made one foot square in the said Christian Lantz's mill race where George Lantz may think proper for the convenience of watering the said George Lantz's meadows" (Bell, 1898, p. 92).

"The Lantz mill was situated west of Leitersburg on the opposite side of the Antietam creek and a short distance above the turnpike bridge over that stream. At the beginning of the century this crossing is referred to as "Lantz's fording on the Nicholson's Gap road." From Christian Lantz, Jr., the son of the first proprietor, the mill passed to his son-in-law, John Byer, by whom several other manufacturing establishments were also operated here. These included a saw-mill, tannery, hemp-mill, and distillery. Fowler & Ziegler subsequently bought the property, equipped the mill with new machinery, and transacted an extensive business, which rapidly declined after they discontinued operations" (Bell, 1898, p. 92).

Christian Lantz died in 1798, and some of his lands were inherited by his son George who was married to Barbara Ziegler. Herbert C. Bell in his *History of Leitersburg District* credits George Lantz with building the stone mansion along the turnpike..., about the year 1800. Court records show that George Lantz died in 1801 at the age of 35 and that his daughter Rose Ann who married Frederick Ziegler inherited his home. - See more at: <http://washingtoncountyhistoricaltrust.org/85-lantz-zeigler-farm-circa-1800-near-leitersburg-md/#sthash.IH3bwq3h.dpuf>

Bell (1898) states that Christian was a member of the Lutheran Church, serving as elder in the Jacobs congregation in 1795-96 and as treasurer for several years. He died in 1798, leaving a widow Elizabeth, and three children: Christian; George, and Rosanna, who married Frederick Boyer" (Byer) (Bell, 1898, p. 217).

Jacob's Lutheran Church Communicants in 1796 included Christian Lantz and wife Elizabeth (source: *Pennsylvania and New Jersey, Church and Town Records, 1708-1985*).

In his will, dated 25 July, 1791, probated 24 Feb 1798, he left money and land to his children, Christian, Rosana the wife of Frederick Boyer, and George, and to a grandson.

2. CHRISTIAN³ LANTZ, JR. (CHRISTIAN², UNKNOWN¹)³ was born Abt. 1758 in Lancaster Co, PA, and died April 02, 1811 in Leitersburg District, Washington, MD. He married ELIZABETH Abt. 1776. She was born Abt. 1760, and died Aft. 1811.

Notes for CHRISTIAN LANTZ, JR.: He inherited the mill property upon his father's death along with considerable nearby land. He resided there until his death. Christian's obituary appeared 9 April 1811 in the *Hagerstown Gazette*.

On 2 April 2015, I searched all of the wills for 1811 in Washington Co, MD in FamilySearch and did not find a will for Christian Lantz.

There is a record for the baptism of John Christian Lens on 2 Aug 1756 at Cocalico (All Pennsylvania Church Records - Adams, Berks, and Lancaster Counties, 1729-1881 results for Christian, Ancestry.com). In the same records, I found a marriage for John Christian Lens but the bride's name is not given.

1800 census, Elizabeth Hundred, Washington, Maryland: Christian Lantz (26-44) with 2 boys (10-15), 1 girl (under 10), 1 girl (10-15), and presumed wife (26-44). Total = 6

1810 census, Elizabeth Hundred, Washington, Maryland: Christian Lantz (45+) with 1 boy (under 10), 1 boy (10-15), and presumed wife (45+). Total = 3

1820 census, Washington County, MD: Samuel Lantz was the only one of that name.

Notes for JOHN BYER, CAPTAIN: There is a record in the Maryland State Archives, Chancery Papers for 16 June 1824, the case of Williard vs Lantz, concerning the Estate of Jacob Rit. John served as a Captain of Militia during the War of 1812.

"Captain John Byer was born in Lancaster County, Pa., January 31, 1777, the son of Frederick and Anna Margaret (Moyer) Byer. Frederick Byer was born in Germany, December 20, 1732, and came to America in 1740 with his mother, his father having died on the voyage. He died on the 19th of February, 1801. Captain Byer probably became a resident of Washington County about the year 1800. In 1803 he married Catharine Study, and two children were born to them: Anna Margaret, who married William E. Doyle, and Frederick. Their mother having died, he married in 1809 Elizabeth, daughter of Christian Lantz, who inherited from her father the mill property near Leitersburg subsequently owned by Fowler & Ziegler. Here Captain Byer engaged extensively in milling and distilling; he also operated a tannery and other industries. In the local militia he held the rank of captain, and in the War of 1812 marched as far as Boonsboro with his company. After disposing of his property at Leitersburg he removed to Hagerstown, where he owned the Antietam House, a hotel that occupied the present site of the Hotel Hamilton. He died in that city on the 12th of February, 1859. Captain Byer was a member of the Lutheran Church (Bell, 1898, p. 274).

1850 census, Hagerstown, Washington Co, MD: Capt. Byers (68) lived with his daughter, Margaret and her husband, William E. Doyle. Occupation was "none" and he had property worth \$2000.

3. ROSENA ELIZABETH³ LANTZ (*CHRISTIAN*², *UNKNOWN*¹) was born August 13, 1760 in Lancaster Co, PA?, and died 1818 in Bedford Co. or Antrim, Franklin Co, PA, age 57. She married FREDERICK BYER, JR. Abt. 1785 in MD or PA, son of FREDERICK BYER and ANNA MOYER. He was born February 11, 1758 in Frederick Co, MD, and died January 1823 in PA, prob. Napier Twp, Bedford County.

Notes for ROSENA ELIZABETH LANTZ: No birth or baptism record has been found for Rosana. *Lancaster Births* by Humphrey does not have her listed. "History of Leitersburg" by Bell (1898) and her father's will both show that Rosanna married Frederick Boyer (Byer). Rosena Elizabeth (Lantz) Byer died in 1818, aged 57 (need source). Her burial place has not been located.

Notes for FREDERICK BYER, JR.: Frederick was born in Frederick Co, MD which was created in 1748 from Prince Georges and Baltimore Counties (need source). This implies that his father was one of the earliest settlers in Frederick Co. In March 1723, a Maryland Proclamation announced special land prices for settlers. He may be the Frederick Byers, Jr. who served under Col. James Johnston, 1780 - 1782. Frederick Byers, Jr. (and Sr.) is listed in the 1786 taxables list for Franklin County, PA, Antrim Township. He was of Antrim Twp, Franklin Co, PA and was probably a blacksmith, like his father. Did he receive western PA land in return for his service? Frederick and

Rosanna Byers served as witnesses for the will of John Hauk of Antrim Twp, blacksmith on 26 Nov 1798 (source: *Wills: Abstract and Letters of Administration, Franklin Co, PA*, on USGenWeb Archives, 2002, by Carolyn K. Shearer). This indicates they moved to western PA after 1798.

Upon the death of his father in October 1800, Frederick II received as his inheritance the plantation on which he then lived, joining lands of John Gearhart and others. Sometime after 1800, Frederick II moved to Bedford County, PA. In the 1810 US Census, a Frederick Byers is shown in Antrim, Franklin County, again with a large family. A male 45 and over could be Frederick II, and a female 45 and over could be Rosena, his wife, but no female 10-15 is tallied, so his daughter, Rosena (12) is not accounted for. Also in 1810, a Frederick Bugers (the original census form could be interpreted as Buyers) is listed in Providence, Bedford County, PA. This family includes a male 45 and over, a female 45 and over, and a female 10-15. Others tallied are not identified.

Frederick II married (before 1791), Rosena Elizabeth Lantz, second child, and only daughter, of Christian and Elizabeth Lantz, born in 1760. Frederick II and Rosena witnessed the will of John Hauk, blacksmith, of Antrim Township in November 1798.

In 1819, Frederick Byer and Jacob Hill are named in a Bedford County Court Record (judgment for a debt). This establishes Frederick II in Bedford County and links him with Jacob Hill, the husband of his daughter, Rosena Elizabeth (Byer).

“To all people to whom these presents shall come I George Mullin Esquire High Sheriff of the county of Bedford in the commonwealth of Pennsylvania send greetings. Whereas Isabella Reed for the use of Solomon Sparks, lately in the County Court of Common Pleas, holden at Bedford for the County of Bedford before the Judges of the same court, to wit, on the ninth day of February in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and nineteen upon the report of arbitrators obtained judgment against Jacob Hill and Frederick Byer as well for a certain debt of one hundred and four dollars and sixty five cents, as forty two dollars and sixty cents which was adjudged in the same court to the said Isabella for her costs sustained by occasion of the detension of that debt and whereas Robert _____ for the use of George Henry lately in the County Court of Common Pleas holden at Bedford for the County of Bedford before the judges of the same court to wit at November term in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty one by the judges of the same court did recover against Abraham Devebaugh executor of John Devebaugh deceased as well a certain debt of sixty six dollars ninety one and a half cents as also eight dollars and sixty three cents which to the said Robert were adjudged in the same court for his costs _____.

And whereas the President and Managers of the Chambersburg and Bedford Turnpike Road Company lately in the County Court of Common Pleas held at Bedford for the County of Bedford before the judges of the same court to wit at April term in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty one by the Judgment of the same court did recover against Ann Snively and William Hartley Executors of the last will of Jacob Snively deceased as well a certain debt of three hundred and sixty seven dollars and two cents as also four dollars and seventy seven and three fourths cents which to the said Company were adjudged for its costs. And whereas afterwards by a court of the Commonwealth afore said officer fascias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas aforesaid _____ the tenth day of Novemia Anno Domine one thousand eight hundred and twenty one and to George W. Barker Esquire then high sheriff of the said County of Bedford directed he was commanded that of the goods and chattels lands and _____ents of Jacob Hill and Frederick Byer the defendants in the first above recited judgment, in his bailiwick he should caused to be made a hired as well the said debt of one hundred and four dollars and sixty five cents as the said forty two dollars and sixty cents of costs which the said Isabella Reed for the use of Solomon Sparks had recovered against the said Jacob Hill and Frederick Byer as aforesaid and that he should have that money Before the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas aforesaid on the first Monday of January then next to render the said Solomon Sparks in the said writ named and the said writ. To which the said Sheriff _____ in the said court that by virtue of the said writ to him directed he had seized and taken in execution all the right title and interest of Frederick Byer of in and to one tract of land situate in Providence Township in snake spring valley containing sixty one acres and three fourths of an acre be the same more or less adjoining land Dewalt Syinger Simon Stooky and _____ “

ML Note: This is the first document I've found that links Frederick Byer and Jacob Hill. Frederick's daughter Rosena Elizabeth Byer married Jacob Hill. This also documents that Frederick Byer, Jr. was in Bedford Co, PA at least by 9 Feb 1819. Land records were searched for Frederick but nothing was found.

1810 census, Antrim, Franklin, Pennsylvania: 1 male (age 10-15); 1 male - Frederick (age 26-44); 1 female (age 10-15); 1 female - Rosena (age 26-44).

1820 census, Antrim, Franklin, Pennsylvania: 2 males (aged 10-15); 1 male (age 16-18); 1 male - (age 26-44); 1 male (age 45+); 1 female (age 16-25). Note that Frederick's wife does not appear to be listed so she is presumed dead before 1820.

Frederick Byer of Napier Twp. - Will mentions: daughter, Rosina Hill; the children of daughter Rosina; grandson Frederick Byer Hill; nephew John Boyer (son of his brother, John); friend John Baird; 400 acre tract in Indiana Co. to brother, John; all demands due from the estate of Jacob Snively. The executors were friends John Smith of Napier Twp. and George Burd, Esq. of Bedford. Witnesses were James Williams and Elijah Adams. The will was dated Jan. 21, 1823 and proved Feb. 6, 1823 (Source: *Bedford County, Pa. Will Book #2*, p. 86).

Frederick II died in January 1823, aged 64. His will, dated January 21, 1823, shows him to be of Napier, Bedford County, PA. The will was proved February 6, 1823. No information about his burial location has been found.

4. GEORGE³ LANTZ (*CHRISTIAN*², *UNKNOWN*¹) was born May 19, 1766 in Lancaster Co, PA⁷, and died April 22, 1802 in Leitersburg District, Maryland, age 35y 11m 3d⁸. He married BARBARA ZIEGLER in Maryland. She was born 1765, and died August 29, 1823 in Leitersburg District, Maryland, age 58, Ziegler Burial Grounds [formerly Lantz Burial Grounds]⁹.

Notes for GEORGE LANTZ: In 1792, his father assigned a farm to him which lay along the Turnpike and Antietam Creek in MD. About 1800 he built a stone mansion along the turnpike, on part of his father's estate "embracing the farm of George F. Ziegler" which was subsequently the residence of his son-in-law, Frederick Ziegler and his grandson, Frederick K. Ziegler (Bell, 1898, p. 218). "Among the oldest stone houses within the limits of the [Leitersburg] District is that on the farm of George F. Ziegler near Leitersburg, built by George Lantz, who died in 1802."

5. CHRISTIAN⁴ LANTZ (*CHRISTIAN*³, *CHRISTIAN*², *UNKNOWN*¹) was born October 07, 1777 in Leitersburg District, MD, and died August 27, 1860 in Leitersburg District, MD, interred Saint Paul's Lutheran Cemetery¹⁰. He married ESTHER "HUDA" MUSSELMAN¹¹ August 07, 1804 in Washington Co, MD¹². She was born August 30, 1784 in MD, and died August 09, 1862 in Leitersburg, MD, interred Saint Paul's Lutheran Cemetery.

Notes for CHRISTIAN LANTZ: "In 1815 Christian Lantz manumitted his slave Charles Bryson, aged thirty-eight years, at the consideration of \$600.00" (Bell, H. *History of Leitersburg District, Washington County, Maryland*, 1898). Bell (1898) shows his death as 27 Aug 1860, but Christian and his wife were still living in Sept. 1860 when the census was taken.

Christian Lantz, son of Christian and Elizabeth Lantz was born in Leitersburg District, Md., October 7, 1777. He married Esther Musselman. He inherited a part of his father's estate (The Mill Property on the Antietam) and was a farmer. He died Aug. 27, 1860. He had the following children: Christian; George W., Samuel; Rosann Elizabeth, married Henry Zeller and lived in Wash. Co., Md.; Caroline, unmarried; and Catherine, married William Crum (Bell, 1898, p. 218).

1860 (Sept) census, Leitersburg, Washington Co, MD living with John & Lydia Cuppick family: Christian (82) and Huda (76) Lance with children Caroline (30) and James (21). Christian had personal property worth \$100. John Cuppick was a Weaver.

Notes for ROSE ANN ELIZABETH LANTZ:

1850 census, District 1, Washington, Maryland: Henry Zeller (21) lived in the Daniel Zeller (57) household with Rachel Zeller (34) and Abraham Everson (21).

1860 census, Hagerstown, Conococheague, Washington, Maryland: Henry (31) and Owenna S. (30) Zeller with children Daniel (8), Mary (7), Parkall E (5), Ann A. (3). Also Mary Wolford (54), Sarah Wolford (17) and Sarah Lyle (72). Henry was a farmer with property worth \$1500.

1870 census, Hagerstown, District 13, Washington, Maryland: Henry (41) and Ann C. (39) Zeller with children Daniel E. (11), Mary C. (17), Rachel (15), Annie (13), Charles (10), Lulu (6), and David (3). Also Thomas Mills (41) and James Rhodes (35).

1880 census – not found

1900 census, Hagerstown, Washington, Maryland: Henry S. Zeller (71) lived with his son Bruce and family.

He married Elizabeth Fehl, of Lancaster County, Pa., a daughter of Jacob Fehl and niece of Frederick and Lewis Ziegler of Leitersburg District, and they were the parents of two sons, Oliver F. and Jacob F. Samuel Lantz was a Democrat in politics until the election of Harrison, for whom he cast his last presidential vote.
